
What are they all about?



Facebook allows you to create a page all about yourself. There is the opportunity for sharing photos and videos and talking to



Twitter lets you post public or private 'Tweets', send and receive private messages and post videos/pictures.



Snapchat allows you to send messages or photos to other users. The pictures can only be viewed for a set amount of time.



WhatsApp is an instant messenger app that allows you to send messages to other users. Photos, videos and locations can also be shared.



YouTube allows you to watch, create and comment on videos on a public profile.



Instagram is a photo and video sharing app. You can send and receive messages.




Skype allows you to send messages and make audio and video calls to others around the world.







We ask our pupils to remember vital information if they come across something that could pose a risk...








